Requirements list for 'Daffodils'

Faber-Castell **polychromos** are the recommended pencils and can be bought online, through various sites such as Jackson's Art, Cult Pens etc.

For this video I used Clairefontaine Paint On paper in white.

FABER CASTELL POLYCHROMOS PENCILS

Pencils from the Faber Castell <u>Polychromos</u> range (please be aware that the pencils listed are what I used according to my reference. You may choose others depending on the colours in your subject).

White 101 or Ivory 103

Cadmium Yellow 107

Dark Cadmium Yellow 108

Manganese Violet 160 (Purple Violet 136 is also good)

Dark Sepia 175

For the stalk:

Earth Green Yellowish and Chromium Green Opaque

You will also need a SOFT CHALKY PASTEL in any light ochre colour, tracing paper, white eraser, putty eraser and <u>good</u> sharpener.

A good quality, smooth white drawing paper, no thinner than 200gsm will be ideal.

I worked on white Clairefontaine 'Paint On', but you could use a HP watercolour paper or a Bristol Board.
